MARINE ENGINEER (MEC III)

This programme is approved and a significant part of the Maritime New Zealand (MNZ) training requirements for students to gain the internationally recognised Standards of Training and Certification of Watchkeepers (STCW) Officer in Charge of an Engineering Watch Class 3 certificate of competency or Maritime New Zealand Seafarer Certification and Operational Limits Framework Class 4 certificate of competency.

Duration : 12 Months @ Sea

You will earn a minimum stipend of \$200 /Month Hands on Training will be provided on the Ship on the various aspect of STCW and other requirement. Students will be closely monitored on regular basis Training Record Book (TAR Book) which will make you eligible to attend the Block course and the same will be presented to Maritime New Zealand (MNZ) prior to the Oral Examination. It's a mandatory that all the students should keep track of their TAR book along with projects mentioned in the TAR BOOK.

Duration : 5 Months @ SMC

You will get trained on the Standards of Training and Certification of Watchkeepers (STCW) and basic knowledge of Shipping and how it operates. Prepare the students to get in to the ship to fulfil the Sea time Requirement. You will be prepared for the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) to fulfil the entry criteria to study at NMIT
