

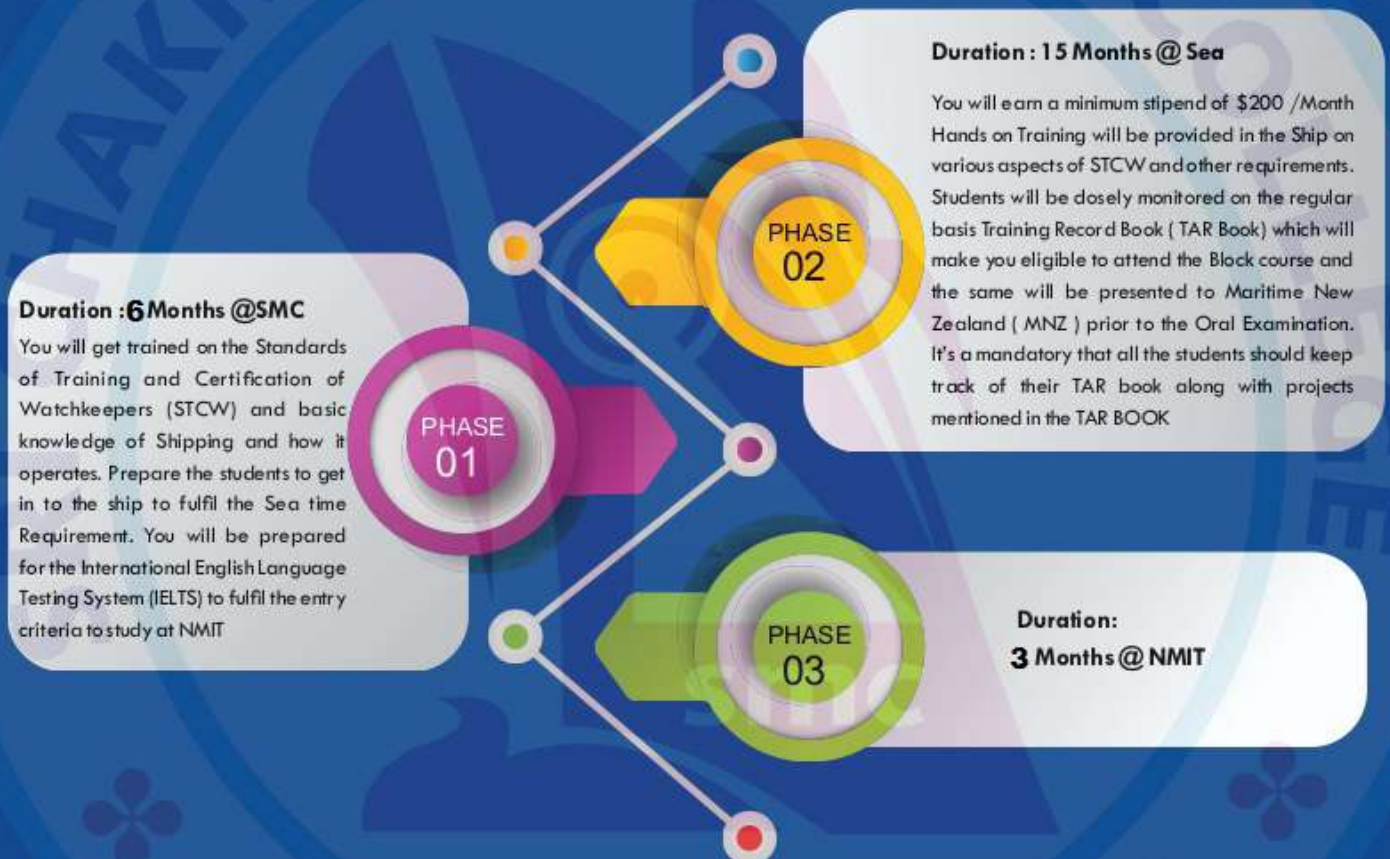
# DIPLOMA IN NAUTICAL STUDIES

## DECK WATCHKEEPER PROGRAMME

( Approved by International Maritime Institute of New Zealand )

### 24 Months

This programme is approved and a significant part of the Maritime New Zealand (MNZ) training requirements for students to gain the internationally recognised Standards of Training and Certification of Watchkeepers (STCW) Officer in Charge of a Deck watchkeeper and to obtain the Certificate of Competency

- 8 Master Orals 2 Weeks
- 7 Master Sea Time - 20 Months
- 6 Practical Advance diploma studies college 3 Months
- 5 Chief Mates Sea Time 24 Months
- 4 Academic Advances Diploma Studies (Recomended) College 6 Months
- 3 COC Preparatory course Exam, Oral, STCW obtain COC3
- 2 First Sea Phase 15 Months with SSTP
- 1 Pre Sea Training 6 Months

### ELIGIBILITY:

**Educational Qualification :** 12th Std with PCM (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) or any degree

**Age limit:** 17.6 and above

**Physical Requirement:** Medically fit as per the M.S. ( Medical Examination of Seafarer ) rules 2000 as amended from time to time

**Eyesight Standard :** Vision 6/6 with normal colour vision
